

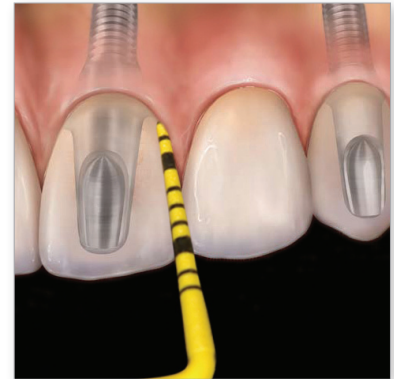

- Radiographic evaluation
- Evaluate crestal bone levels
- Is there any bone loss?
- Review previous radiographs for comparison
- Evaluate the prosthesis and components for adequacy
- Are the components intact?
- Do o-rings, clips or attachments need replacement?
- Is the home care adequate for the removable prosthesis?
- Evaluate mobility
- Atraumatically remove all soft and hard deposits on abutments and restorations
- Development of patient specific oral hygiene routine
- Determination of appropriate re-care interval
- Documentation
